


A model of mobility


Completion of building section 1 is planned for 2023. The entire project including building sections 3 and 4 will be completed in 2024.

Enjoyment



Whether it's a small snack in between meals or buying the weekly groceries for the family in the evening. Employees can do their shopping without any fuss at the grocery store directly on campus.




Sleeping

The main railway station in Linz is only four tram stops away from Techbase Linz.

All roads lead to Techbase Linz

Techbase Linz is located in the southern part of the provincial capital and boasts an ideal location and infrastructure. It can be reached quickly and easily by car via the A7 motorway. The campus site also enjoys excellent tram and bus links to the public transport network. The road network in Linz has also been well extended with cycle paths. Similarly, the ÖBB main railway station in Linz is only four tram stops away from Techbase Linz.

Linz can be reached by direct flights from Frankfurt, Düsseldorf, Zurich or Vienna to Linz/Hörsching airport.

From Techbase Linz you can reach the city centre quickly:


By bike 3.5 km approx. 12 min By tram 3.5 km approx. 13 min By taxi 4.0 km approx. 10 min




A7 exitTram stop
